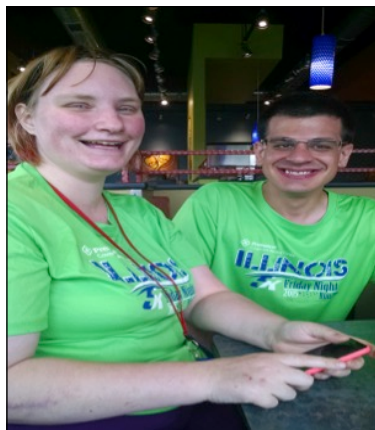
Annual Report

Since springtime this year, Community Choices has been partnering with the Unitarian Universalist Church as a place to house our Life Skills Classes.

Community Choices has been utilizing two basement classrooms on Tuesday afternoons to offer a variety of classes. In the past year, we have offered classes such as: Hobby Discovery, a Men's Support Group, a Women's Support Group, and a Getting Ready to Move Out class.

As a part of our Community Living services, these classes are aimed at helping individuals learn the skills to become more independent. Often, we partner with the University of Illinois Special Education department to have their students facilitate these classes. We aim to offer two per semester, with one during the summer. The Unitarian Church has been a great asset in helping us to offer these classes.
