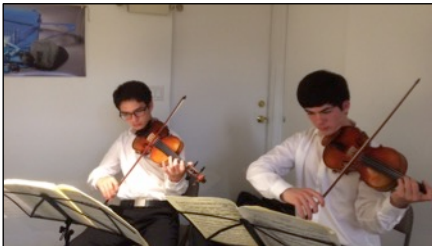


CATCHING UP

Co-op Clubs are NOT staffed by Community Choices. Each club will have a volunteer Organizer who will help the group plan the events and provide transportation if needed.

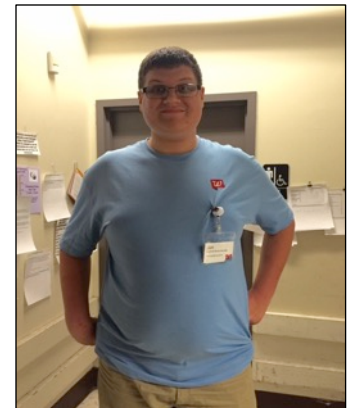
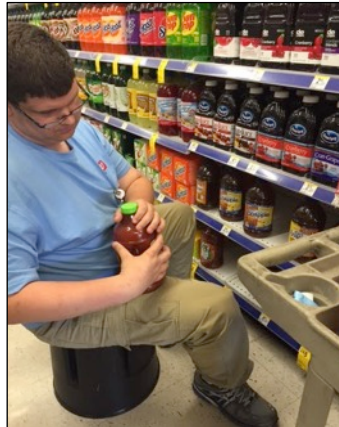
